Introduction

Introduction

This catalog represents the most comprehensive collection of outdoor site furnishings available from any single manufacturer. More than three decades ago site-related products bearing the TimberForm trade name were introduced to the design community. These original benches were made of large Douglas fir timbers. Columbia Cascade has expanded its lines yearly until now they encompass hundreds of different wood as well as colorful metal site furnishing products. Shown on these pages are a wide variety of site complements destined "For Signature ProjectsSM".

Design Families

Each model is part of a complete family— each family meeting different design, application and budget requirements. Among the products are traditional public park furnishings, classic restoration styles for urban renovation or campus projects and contemporary designs for streetscapes, shopping centers and office environs. Complementary litter containers, ash receptacles and accessories complete each of the design families.

Products are assembled and presented within design families. Each product within a family has been designed and crafted to complement each other. When an accessory from another design series also complements an illustrated product it is cross-referenced.

Virtually any conceivable site furnishing need is addressed somewhere in this catalog.

Tables, Chairs and Seats

Table, chair and seat combinations are found within most design families. These are presented in the sections entitled **Tables** and **Chairs and Seats** and referenced in the appropriate design family section.

Lexicon of Terms

We use the term **Seat** to describe a seating product without a backrest. The term **Bench** indicates that it has a backrest. Litter containers available without a top cover are specified with the suffix **-OT** for *open top*. For a flat metal top with a reduced center opening specify **-FT** for *flat top*. A domed metal top, open on opposite sides, is specified by the suffix **-DT** for *dome top*. For a *domed top plus a smokers ash receptacle* the suffix **-AT** is used. Tops, with a hinged self-closing door(s), are indicated by **-HT** for *hamper top*.

Three mounting methods appear in this catalog. Permanent mounting by embedment in a concrete footing is

indicated by the suffix **-E**. Fixed surface mounting (where the pavement is already in place) is indicated by **-P** for pedestal mount. Neither re-bar (**-E**) nor anchoring bolts (**-P**) are included. Movable, non-fixed applications, usually for secure indoor areas, are specified with the suffix **-L** for leveling. The **-L** leg base is capped with a nylon pad to minimize the potential of marring terrazzo or polished floors.

General Information

Slats

Bench and seat slats plus surrounds for litter containers, ash receptacles, bollards and PipeLeaners are offered in wood or (on many products) recycled plastic.

Four species of wood have been carefully selected for use in the production of those TimberForm Site Complements which include wood components.

Clear Alaska yellow cedar is supplied as standard on TimberForm **Broadway**, **Craftsmen**, **Palomar**, **Plaza**, **Restoration**, and **Skyline** products. Durable Marine Teak or Purpleheart hardwoods are offered as an option for these design families.

Premium Douglas fir timber is provided on TimberForm **Arbor**, **Greenway**, **Madison**, **Parkway** and for timber bollards.

Quality

All wood used in TimberForm site furniture is free-of-heart-center (F.O.H.C.). This specification is added assurance that the wood is of premium quality. After seasoning, surfacing or dressing, wood components are inspected for appearance and only suitable specimens are accepted for use.

Alaska Yellow Cedar

Kiln-dried Alaska yellow cedar is the informed specifier's choice for bench slats. This species offers extraordinary qualities for seating purposes. Naturally immune to most effects of weathering and decay, the wood is a uniform pale yellow in color when new and ages to a rich sable gray in outdoor situations. It is silky smooth and sliver free. Alaska yellow cedar has been considered the species of choice for outdoor stadium seating for over a century.

Marine Teak

Marine Teak, a tropical hardwood, is a rich reddish-brown color when shipped. Left unfinished it weathers to a handsome warm-gray. Teak is the species most specified and preferred by quality yacht builders throughout the world because of its ability to withstand harsh marine environments while exhibiting minimal deterioration with age.

Purpleheart

Purpleheart is a dense, durable tropical hardwood also appropriate for vigorous use. It appears purplish in color when freshly milled and ages to a rich mid-gray when exposed to normal weathering. After an annual cycle outdoors, its appearance is very close to Marine Teak

Douglas Fir

Douglas fir is a tough and durable structural wood well-suited to the demands of public seating when the finest clear grades are used. It varies in color from shades of salmon to ivory and eventually ages to a natural mid-gray in outdoor settings.

Wood Fabrication

All wood components destined for TimberForm site products are dressed four sides to a smooth finish. Edges are carefully eased (rounded), ends chamfered or eased too. Hand-finishing occurs prior to final quality control acceptance.

Wood Preservation

Because of the inherent natural preservatives contained in Alaska yellow cedar, Marine Teak and Purpleheart, additional chemical treatment after fabrication is not required.

Douglas fir components destined for exterior use are treated with a water-repellent wood preservative formulated to prolong the life of this species in demanding outdoor applications. If the intended location of products using Douglas fir is to be indoors, or if for some other reason preservative treatment is not desired or required, we must be notified at the time of order entry not to treat these components.

Staining and Sealing

TimberForm wood components are supplied in their natural state. After prolonged exposure to the sun's ultraviolet rays, all wood will mature to varying shades of gray. To counteract this natural metamorphosis, some specifiers prefer for the wood to be stained.

For uniformity of color, staining must be done on site following assembly and installation. Since staining, like painting, requires regular refinishing to maintain an attractive appearance, most owners prefer to allow the wood simply to age naturally.

For indoor use, wood components may be finished on site with oils, varnishes, synthetic resins, or any other clear or tinted finish appropriate for the intended use. Carefully follow the finish manufacturer's instructions applicable to kiln-dried new wood.

Recycled Plastic Slats



Recycled plastic slats are available instead of wood on many benches, litter containers and tables within the TimberForm **Restoration, Broadway, Madison, Parkway** and **Greenway** series.

This option is selected for reasons of durability, maintenance and a desire to recycle plastics. Not all recycled plastic offers a quality result and all re-cycled plastic products are more expensive than Douglas fir versions.

Other Slat Options

Hollow metal slats are available instead of wood on several models within the TimberForm **Craftsmen, Restoration,** and **Skyline** series.



Powder Coating

After careful mechanical and chemical cleaning and following the application of corrosion-inhibiting iron phosphate, all fabricated steel, aluminum and cast iron components used in producing TimberForm Site Complements are powder-coated with **CASPAX-7**. This lead-free polyester powder is electrostatically applied and chemically bonded to the metal substrate in precision ovens at 400 degrees Fahrenheit. The tough, 6-8 mil thick coating offers lasting performance far superior to familiar liquid finishes. The difference is particularly apparent when installed products are exposed to outdoor environments or public usage.

CASPAX-7 powder-coated metal components are much more resistant to the effects of abrasion, impact, temperature extremes, natural corrosives and UV degradation than any other colored finish available for site complements.

Coating Colors and Quick Shipment

All metal products and components are offered in ten standard and a unique spectrum of nearly 200 special **CASPAX-7** designer colors. To view the complete selections of available powder-coating colors, ask your Columbia Cascade representative to show you a **ColorCard™** and a **ColorBook™**.

Many popular TimberForm site products are available for immediate "Quick Shipment" stocked in black only. Other popular products are stocked ready for color coating and prompt 14-day "Quick Shipment" in a choice of standard TimberForm black, brown, burgundy, Chrome Yellow, Coffee Tan, Evergreen, Ocean Teal, red, Regal Blue or white.

Specifications, Drawings and Samples

When product technical information is required, such as dimensioned drawings or specifications for bid documents; powder-coated metal or actual wood samples for client presentations, contact your nearby TimberForm Site Complements representative or us at the factory.

Unless otherwise noted, all drawings appearing in this catalog are reproduced in the scale of $3/8" = 1'$.

Installation

To reduce delivery charges, most TimberForm Site Complements are shipped partially or completely unassembled, though a few models are shipped assembled. All requisite hardware and fastenings other than anchoring bolts (for -P surface mounting) and steel reinforcing bar (for -E embedment mounting) are included with each model. Supplied stainless steel fasteners required for the attachment of slats are Phillips head, facilitating use of powered tools. Your TimberForm Site Complements representative will gladly furnish you with information regarding the assembly necessary for each model.

All products appearing in this catalog are listed on a separate price list which includes estimated shipping weights along with our standard terms of sale.
